



Curbside Recycling

Recycling is a community effort. In order for your recycling program to be successful, we ask each resident to comply with the listed items below. Recycling reduces operational costs and protects the environment.

CATEGORY	ACCEPTABLE ITEMS	NON-ACCEPTABLE ITEMS	COMMENTS
Paper Products	Brochures Catalogs, Magazines Cereal Boxes Computer Paper Cardboard Corrugated, Boxes Mixed Paper, Office Paper Newspaper (dry) Phone Books Junk Mail	Facial Tissue Food Contaminated Paper Newspaper (Wet) Paper Towels Tissue Paper	(Plastic bags need to be removed from newspapers. Newspaper must be dry.)
Aluminum & Metal Cans	Beverage Cans Food Cans	Aerosol Cans Aluminum Foil Paint Cans Pie Tins	(Cans should be rinsed but labels can remain.)
No curbside collection of glass containers or items - see below (Recycling Center)			
Plastic Products	# 1 thru # 7 Bottles & Plastics	Antifreeze Bottles Motor Oil Containers Plastic Bags Plastic Wrap Styrofoam	(Containers should be rinsed and caps and lids removed, but labels can remain.) Remove all Plastic Rings and Lids. (Lids and Rings on bottles and containers. 6-pack can rings)
Used Motor Oil	To recycle used motor oil, place the used motor oil in a clear plastic 1-gallon milk jug and set it next to your recycling bin on your recycling day. <u>Do not mix any other products with the motor oil.</u>
