## Table Reservations

 - through Parks & Recreation

Reserve a table for one or all of the indicated (below) City of Smyrna concert events. Reservations must be made in person at the Wolf Adult Recreation Center (884 Church Street) May 16 through May 26, 2015. Non-Resident may register after May 26. Proof of City residency is required (photo ID with City water bill or tax bill and driver's license).

The City of Smyrna/Parks & Recreation reserves the right to adjust or limit the number of tables, and/or adjust table placement and location. Reservations are made on a first come-first served basis and are limited to two (2) tables per party per concert. Tables are 48" rounds with seating for six (6). There will be no refunds for no-shows. Cancellations must be made one week prior to the concert date to be eligible for a refund. (No shows are subject to loss of table reservations for the remainder of the concert dates.)
